Update from the Chairman

This week, our Chairman attended three meetings representing the Confederation and the Armed Forces Community. On Tuesday, the Forces in Mind Trust Board held their final meeting of the year. The Trust has stepped up a gear over the last twelve months and has increasingly been involved not only in developing the factual basis for change but also influencing key decision makers. On Wednesday he attended Contact, the mental health Action Group. The agenda continues to focus upon collaboration, cooperation and best practise, significant progress is being made. On Wednesday he chaired the Advisory Steering Group of the War Pensions and Armed Forces Compensation Committee. The agenda addressed delays in appeals coming before the tribunal, and the support provided to appellants.
